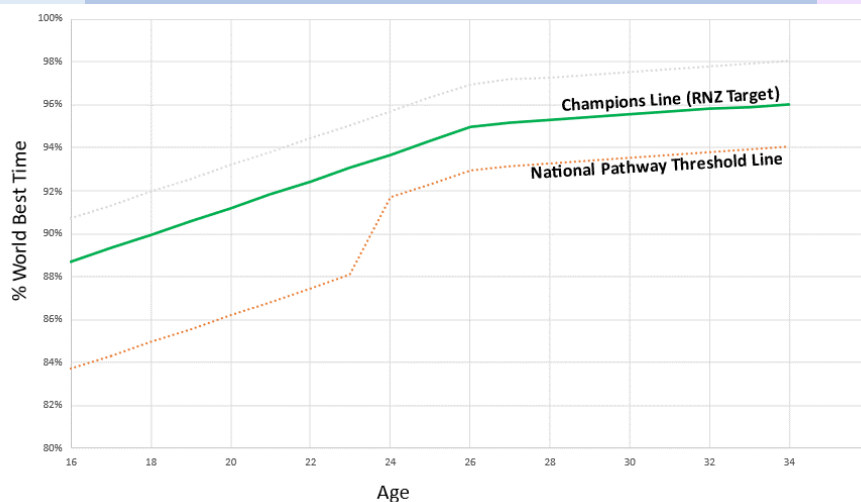
Tier 1

Selection to Tier 1 for those not meeting the automatic selection criteria is at the discretion of the National Pathway Selection panel and contingent upon consistent performances on the water and in physical performance metrics such as ergometer testing.

Athletes wanting to gain selection to Tier one should be:

- targeting Premier single sculling events at the National Championships and major regattas
- tracking around the Champions line on their individual ergometer performances
