

The NZRA Board provide the following amendments to its proposed Rule change listed as Remit 1 in the 2020 NZRA AGM Agenda.

1. Re-Classification by Application to NZRA – Date Change

Therefore including the above amendments to the proposed rule change Rule 13.5 would read in full as follows:

3. Re-Classification by Application to NZRA

- a) A rower may apply to NZRA for re-classification to Intermediate or Club or Senior.
- b) A rower may only apply if seeking re-classification at the start of the following Season to:
 1. move up more than one class; or
 2. remain in their current class instead of moving up a class; or
 3. move down one class instead of remaining in their current class.
- c) NZRA shall consider applications that:
 1. have the support of the rower's club and Local Association; and
 2. set out a case explaining why NZRA should grant re-classification; and
 3. are received during the off-Season ~~and at least one month before the start of the next Season, or by the first day of November in the current season.~~
- d) When NZRA considers an application it shall reach a decision whether to grant re-classification to the rower as soon as it is practical to do so, and it shall, ~~and~~ notify all parties of that decision, ~~before the end of the off-Season when the application is received.~~
- e) If NZRA grants re-classification during the off-Season then it happens at the start of the next Season. Otherwise re-classification happens when the decision is notified to all parties.
- f) ~~At the start of each Season~~ NZRA will publish a re-classification report as soon as is practical after the application process has concluded. The report will summarise the outcomes of all applications. It may also include such details as NZRA decides may be helpful for future applicants.
